SCSEP helps low-income, unemployed individuals 55 and older find work, matching eligible older adults with part-time training assignments at non-profits or government agencies. The plan serves the needs of the whole family as well as caregivers, so they can achieve job placement, retention, and long-term financial stability.

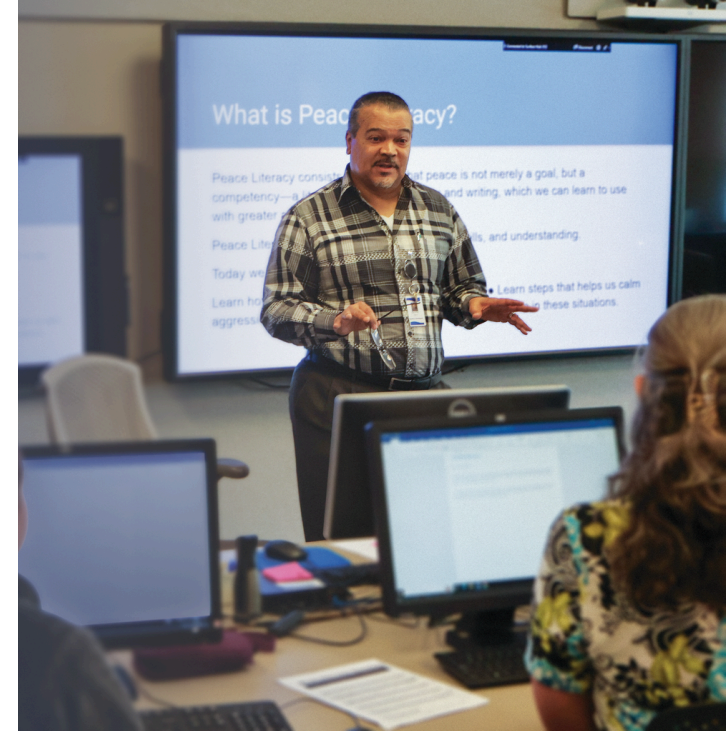

Vocational Offerings

Job Resource Room

Open Monday-Thursday, 9:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m.

Available to the public for job search activities, with access to computers, printers, and supportive staff assistance.

Workshops

Offered weekly and typically last 60-90 minutes.

Topics include digital skills, job search strategies, career development, and financial education.

Career Readiness, Education, and Development (CRED)

Class offered monthly, Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m.-12:00 p.m.

Build the skills and confidence needed for career success. Participants explore career interests, set goals, develop professional portfolios, strengthen interview skills, and learn workplace professionalism and leadership.

Industry Skills

Help Desk Technician

10-week training program focused on hands-on IT skills and preparation for the CompTIA Tech+ certification.

Green Jobs Explorer

8-week program introducing careers in the growing green economy while preparing participants to earn the Energy Industry Fundamentals 2.0 credential.

Brownfields Environmental Job Training

5-week training program that provides seven industry-recognized credentials and prepares participants for careers in environmental remediation and related industries.

Build Strong Construction Academy

In partnership with the Washington Home Builders Foundation. Gain hands-on construction experience and earn a Carpentry Pre-Apprenticeship certificate.

Intermediate Office Skills

10-week hybrid training program preparing students for administrative, office support, and business careers. Earn Microsoft Word and Excel certifications while building in-demand workplace skills.

Industry Pathways

Explore local career opportunities, develop job readiness skills, and earn industry-recognized certificates through these two-week training programs.

Construction and Trades

Learn about careers in the skilled trades and earn entry-level certificates.

Food and Hospitality

Explore opportunities in restaurants, hotels, tourism, and customer service while earning entry-level certificates.

Healthcare Support

Discover career pathways in healthcare and care-focused professions while earning entry-level certificates.

Warehouse and Manufacturing

Explore careers in logistics, warehousing, manufacturing, and supply chain industries while earning entry-level certificates.
